This Memorandum of Agreement entered into this 6th day of April 2022, by and between the following:

The **UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN PHILIPPINES**, a higher education institution accredited by the Commission on Higher Education, created and existing by virtue of Republic Act No. 4449, with principal address at Brgy. Tamag, Vigan City, Ilocos Sur, represented by its President, **ERWIN F. CADORNA, Ph. D.**, hereinafter referred to as the **"UNIVERSITY"**

AND

The **GAWAD KALINGA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION**, a poverty alleviation and nation-building movement with **Gawad Kalinga Sto. Nino at Brgy. Tamurong, Candon City, Ilocos Sur** represented by **DANIEL R. BERCASIO**, Executive Director, and herein after referred to as the **"RECIPIENT"**

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **"UNIVERSITY"** possesses the capability and ability in terms of human and non-human resources to provide the necessary assistance with regard to teacher and student development; sport development; school facilities, building and fixture; parents, barangay officials, etc.;

WHEREAS, Gawad Kalinga is a private foundation which undertakes the role of building communities in depressed areas with the primary objective to become a catalyst in uplifting the quality of life of the poor through Gawad Kalinga program which include shelter, health education and livelihood geared towards an integrated holistic and sustainable development;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereto have agreed to the terms and conditions set forth below.

I. OBLIGATIONS OF "THE UNIVERSITY"

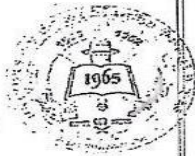

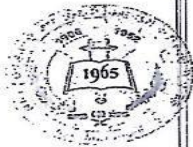
1. Assist in the establishment of the GK Village;

3. Conduct information drive and advocacy programs along identified concerns;
4. Conduct literacy and numeracy program, skills training, technology transfer and livelihood projects;
5. Conduct training on Disaster Preparedness and Management, Basic Life Support and Rescue Operations;
6. Organized a committee that will meet from time to time to monitor and evaluate the progress of projects and the delivery of services in the community;
7. Conducts an impact assessment of the services extended by the university to the recipients;
8. Assist in the establishment, rehabilitation and repair of GK houses, public buildings, facilities and fixtures;
9. Conduct lectures in coaching and officiating sports games;
10. Assist in the outsourcing of funds for entrepreneurial endeavors and other projects;
11. Provide support to activities related to volunteerism and citizen's engagement.

II. BENEFITS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE "RECIPIENTS" (GK Sto. Nino, Bagani Ubbog, Candon City, Ilocos Sur)

The "RECIPIENT" Gawad Kalinga, Sto. Nino, Bagani Ubbog, Candon City, Ilocos Sur Ilocos Sur hereby agrees to the adoption by the "UNIVERSITY and in return for the resources given and the services rendered, pledges to the following:

1. Extend various assistance in the establishment of GK Sites in the different municipalities of Ilocos Sur;
2. Provide avenue for future linkages and networking for the university;
3. Avail to the various livelihood, technology transfer and skills training programs, information dissemination and advocacies and other services extended and provided by the university;
4. Be responsible for the promotion and use of the various knowledge, attitudes and skills learned from the programs;
5. Guarantee the up-keep, maintenance and proper utilization of the equipment, tools, supplies and materials solicited by the university;

III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) That this agreement shall be enforced for a period of three years from April 6, 2022 to April 6, 2025;
- 2) Services other than those mentioned in this Agreement which the **"RECIPIENTS"** may request from the **"UNIVERSITY"** shall be subjected to a separate agreement;
- 3) Any amendment or revision in this Agreement, if and when necessary, shall require the mutual consent of the parties before the same can be considered as part of the AGREEMENT.

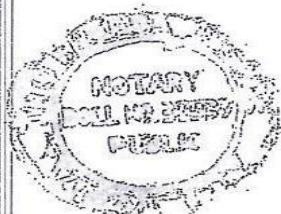

UNP launches first Volunteerism Week

San Sebastian, San Vicente, Ilocos Sur.

The University's Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Garwood Kalilang Community Development Foundation and LGU San Vicente was also renewed. Present at the event were Dr. Erwin F. Cadornio, UNP President; Mr. Jose Luis M. Oquendo, Chairman, CCE Community Development Foundation; Hon. Jose C. Tabanda III, Mayor, San Vicente, Ilocos Sur; Dr. Romeo F. Baccamora, UNP-VP for Research and Extension; Dr. Christopher F. Buena, CCE Director; UNP Extension Office and other UNP faculty and staff.

Aside from the MOA signing, house refurbishing, and clean-up activities were also conducted with the help of the different UNP academic units and offices.

Faculty members from the College of Arts and Sciences and College of Business Administration and Accountancy also led a coastal cleanup at San Vicente, Ilocos Sur.

These activities conducted are part of the university's line-up of events in celebration of Dr. Cadornio's birthday.

CPAD leads Voter's Education Webinar
