MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

For ACADEMIC COOPERATION

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN PHILIPPINES
AND
UNIVERSITAS NAHDLATUL ULAMA SURABAYA



This MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT executed and entered into at the Monday, 19th March, 2018 by and between the;

1. UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN PHILIPPINES, a government institution of higher learning created and existing by virtue of Republic Act No. 4449 with principal office address at Barangay Tamag, Heritage City of Vigan, Province of Ilocos Sur duly represented by its PRESIDENT, GILBERT R. ARCE, hereinafter referred to as "UNP."
2. UNIVERSITAS NAHDLATUL ULAMA SURABAYA, was founded by Yayasan Rumah Sakit Islam "Surabaya" (YARSIS) Embrio establishment began in 1979, namely the establishment of Health Nurse School (SPK) YARSIS with principal office address at Jl. Jemursari 51-57, Wonocolo, Surabaya, Jawa Timur 60237, Indonesia duly represented by its RECTOR, PROF. DR. IR. ACHMAD JAZIDIE, M. Eng., hereinafter referred to as "UNUSA."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, UNP and UNUSA, believing that the process of university education can be enriched and understanding strengthened, and recognizing the benefits to their respective universities from the establishment of links and cooperation, conclude this agreement;

WHEREAS, UNP and UNUSA, agree to enter into an agreement for academic exchange based upon mutual trust, equal benefits and cooperative development;

WHEREAS, UNP and UNUSA, desire to enhance bilateral cooperation in the field of higher education, research and training in

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, UNP and UNUSA hereby mutually agree to the following terms and conditions of agreement.

ARTICLE I - OBJECTIVES

The objective of this Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) is to promote mutual cooperation in education, research and training on a reciprocal basis, for the advancement of knowledge and intellectual development.

ARTICLE II - SCOPE OF COOPERATION

Both institutions agree and shall endeavor to promote collaborative activities in academic areas of mutual interest on a basis of equality and reciprocity which shall include but not be limited to the following:

1. Facilitate the exchange of faculty experts, researchers, academic personnel, and students. The details of the programs will be specified in a separate agreement between the sending and receiving educational institutions of both Parties.
2. Support the exchange of training programs of the recognized educational institutional of both Parties.
3. Facilitate the exchange of literature, research findings, and other related publications, subject to the relevant national laws, rules and regulations of the Parties, as well as, the conventions on intellectual property to which they are members.
4. Implement the possibility of credit transfers between both Parties with the view to concluding an appropriate agreement on credit transfer. Provided that, prior to the conclusion of any agreement on credit transfers, an extensive study will be undertaken by both Parties through mutual consultations and negotiations.
5. Facilitate Joint/Double degree programs.

PASAL I - TUJUAN

Tujuan dari Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) ini adalah untuk mempromosikan kerja sama dalam pendidikan, penelitian dan pelatihan secara timbal balik, untuk kemajuan pengetahuan dan pengembangan intelektual.

PASAL II - RUANG LINGKUP KERJASAMA

Kedua institusi setuju dan harus berusaha untuk mempromosikan kegiatan kolaboratif di bidang akademik yang menjadi kepentingan bersama berdasarkan persamaan dan timbal balik yang harus mencakup namun tidak terbatas pada hal berikut:

1. Memfasilitasi pertukaran tenaga akademik antara fakultas, peneliti, tenaga akademik, dan mahasiswa. Rincian program akan ditentukan dalam kesepakatan terpisah antara institusi pendidikan pengiriman dan penerimaan kedua Peserta.
2. Mendukung pertukaran program pelatihan institusi pendidikan yang diakui kedua Peserta.
3. Memfasilitasi pertukaran literatur, temuan penelitian, dan publikasi terkait lainnya sesuai dengan undang-undang, peraturan dan peraturan nasional yang relevan. Peserta, dan juga konvensi dan kekayaan intelektual yang dimiliki anggotanya.
4. Kaji kemungkinan transfer kredit antara institusi yang diakui dari kedua Peserta dengan tujuan untuk menyimpulkan kesepakatan yang sesuai mengenai transfer kredit. Asalkan sebelum kesepakatan dari transfer kredit, sebuah studi ekstensif akan dilakukan oleh peserta melalui konsultasi dan negosiasi bersama.
5. Memfasilitasi program Joint / Double degree.

6. Jointly conduct and encourage Parties in educational congresses, conferences, workshops, symposia, training courses, exhibits and other activities related to the objectives of this MoA.

ARTICLE III - IMPLEMENTATION

The development and implementation of specific activities based on this Agreement will be separately negotiated and agreed between the faculties, schools or institutes, which carry out the specific projects. UNP and UNUSA agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective institutions after full consultation and approval.

ARTICLE IV - JOINT WORKING GROUP

1. The Parties will establish a Joint Working Group to facilitate the implementation of this MoA.
2. The Joint Working Group will monitor, evaluate and review the implementation of this MoA regularly and submit the reports to the implementing Agencies

ARTICLE V - FUNDING

The cost of the cooperative activities under this MoA shall be funded in terms to be mutually determined by the Parties and shall be subject to the availability of funds.

ARTICLE VI - SUSPENSION

Each Party reserves the right, for reasons of security, public order or public health, to suspend temporarily, either in whole or in part, the implementation of this MoA sixty (60) days after notification has been given to the other party, through government institutions.

ARTICLE VII - CONFIDENTIALITY AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

1. The Parties shall ensure that the educational data, information, and intellectual property rights mutually provided and developed which are carried out under this Memorandum of Agreement, shall not be transferred or supplied to a Third Party without prior written consent of the other party.
2. In case of specific arrangement, program or project that may result in intellectual property rights, the Parties shall enter into a separate agreement in accordance with

PASAL III - IMPLEMENTASI

PASAL IV - JOINT WORKING GROUP

1. Para Pihak akan membentuk Joint Working Group untuk memfasilitasi pelaksanaan MoA ini.
2. Kelompok Kerja Bersama akan memantau, mengevaluasi dan meninjau pelaksanaan MoA ini secara teratur dan menyampaikan laporannya kepada Instansi Pelaksana

PASAL V - PENDANAAN

Biaya kegiatan koperasi di bawah naungan ini didanai dalam hal yang dapat ditentukan oleh Para Pihak dan harus tergantung pada ketersediaan dana.

PASAL VI - PENANGGUHAN

Setiap Pihak berhak atas alasan keamanan, ketertiban umum atau kesehatan masyarakat, untuk menangguhkan sementara, baik secara keseluruhan atau sebagian, pelaksanaan MoA ini yang akan berlaku efektif enam puluh (60) hari setelah pemberitahuan diberikan kepada pihak lain, melalui instansi pemerintah.

PASAL VII - KERAHASIAAN DAN HAK KEKAYAAN INTELEKTUAL

1. Para Pihak harus memastikan bahwa data pendidikan, informasi, dan hak kekayaan intelektual yang telah disediakan dan dikembangkan bersama yang dilaksanakan berdasarkan Memorandum Kesepakatan ini, tidak akan dialihkan atau dipasok ke Pihak Ketiga tanpa persetujuan tertulis dari pihak lainnya.
2. Dalam hal pengaturan, program atau proyek tertentu yang dapat mengakibatkan

their respective laws and regulations.

ARTICLE VIII - SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any dispute arising from the implementation of the provisions of this MoA shall be settled amicably by consultations or negotiation, through government institutions.

ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENT

This MoA may be reviewed and amended at any time, by mutual written consent of the Parties.

ARTICLE X - DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This MoA shall take effect immediately upon signing and shall be effective for a period of 5 (five) years and may be extended for the same period by mutual consent of the Parties through government institutions.
2. The termination of this MoA shall not affect the validity and duration of any arrangements, programs, activities or projects made under this MoA until the completion of such arrangements, programs, activities or projects, unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties.
3. This document is made in 3 (three) master copies with equal legal force.
